### Selection of Student Representatives to the VCU Board of Visitors

1. The President will recommend one graduate/professional student and one undergraduate to serve as either the student representative or the alternate from lists submitted by a selection committee, chaired by the Vice Provost for Student Affairs and Enrollment Services, which would include representation from the student governments on each campus of the University.
2. The student representative and the alternate student representative to the Board of Visitors will be appointed for a one-year term effective July 1 of each year. The student representative and the alternate student representative will be nonvoting representatives and will not be allowed to attend closed sessions of the Board.
3. The student representative and the alternate student representative to the Board of Visitors will serve as nonvoting representatives to the Student Affairs, Athletics and International Programs Committee of the Board. The student representative and the alternate student representative will not serve as a representative to any other Board Committee.
4. The alternate student representative will not have official status, but will be invited to attend full Board meetings and the Student Affairs, Athletics and International Programs committee meeting with voice but no vote.
