

Student Representatives to the VCU Board of Visitors

Selection of Student Representatives to the VCU Board of Visitors

1. The President will recommend one graduate/professional student and one undergraduate to serve as either the student representative or the alternate from lists submitted by a selection committee, chaired by the Associate Vice Provost for Student Affairs and Enrollment Services.
2. The student representative and the alternate student representative to the Board of Visitors will be appointed for a one-year term effective July 1 of each year. The student representative and the alternate student representative will be nonvoting representatives and will not be allowed to attend closed sessions of the Board.
3. The student representative and the alternate student representative to the Board of Visitors will serve as nonvoting representatives to the Student Affairs, Athletics and International Programs Committee of the Board. The student representative and the alternate student representative will not serve as a representative to any other Board Committee.
4. The alternate student representative will not have official status, but will be invited to attend full Board meetings and the Student Affairs, Athletics and International Programs Committee meeting with voice but no vote.

Eligibility Requirements

- Enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate/professional student in good standing
- Maintain continuous full-time enrollment in an undergraduate program or graduate/professional program during the representative term (July 1, 2012 – June 30, 2013)

Selection Process

- Submit the 2012-2013 application
- Submit a one-page letter of application describing his/her interest and qualifications for the position
- Submit supplemental question responses
- Provide a one-page resume or curriculum vita
- Submit all application materials by February 15, 2012 to Dr. Chuck Klink electronically (cjklink@vcu.edu)

The selection committee will review all applications submitted by the deadline. The selection committee will extend an interview to top candidates in March on dates to be determined. After interviews, the selection committee will recommend to the Vice Provost for Student Affairs & Enrollment Services finalists (at least one undergraduate and one professional/graduate student) for consideration by the President. The President

will recommend one undergraduate and one graduate/professional student to the Student Affairs, Athletics and International Programs Committee for its action. The 2012-2013 primary student representative will be a graduate/professional student.
